Shattuck defended its title at the Fifth Annual Interscholastic. The individual star of the meet was 'Cap' Townsend who won the 200 and the Discus, placed third in the 100, and moved his relay team up from 3rd to 2nd on the anchor leg. Well over twenty teams participated and seventeen scored points. Twelve of the fifteen starters in the mile run finished, which was judged by the Mpls. Journal as a good effort by the lads.

The Range schools got together for an Interscholastic, but this meet was not run every year. In years when it was not contested, most Range schools had a field day where the classes competed against each other. In Duluth, freshman Matt Brown, began four years of dominating track & field in the Port City. His sophomore year he was captain and, according to the Duluth News-Tribune, organizing meets.

This was the inaugural year for both the Minneapolis and St. Paul City Meets.

At the Carleton Invitational, the Northfield squad voted unanimously to allow Stillwater to take home the championship trophy (the two teams had tied). Local newspapers applauded their sportsmanship. After meets run at colleges, it was customary for the competitors and their coaches to be hosted at a banquet provided by the school. Carleton would frequently combine their Track Invite with a musical show. In meets run at Hamline, schools that won the Debate competition the night before were awarded up to 40 points toward their track team's score.
